ORDER PERMITTING USE AND DISSEMINATION OF JOHN DOE INFORMATION AND MATERIALS – KELLY RINDFLEISCH

WHEREAS Milwaukee County Assistant District Attorney Bruce J. Landgraf-has requested that the John Doe Judge permit the use and disclosure of information, materials, and transcripts developed in the course of these proceedings as may be reasonably necessary in connection with certain anticipated prosecutions, *viz.*, proceedings to be instituted in connection with campaign activity conducted in the Office of the Milwaukee County Executive's Office during the 2010 election cycle;

NOW THEREFORE, for good cause shown, it is hereby ordered that the District Attorney's Office and any agency assisting the District Attorney's Office are permitted to use and disseminate information, materials, and transcripts obtained and/or gathered in these proceedings as may be reasonably necessary in connection with the anticipated prosecution of Kelly Rindfleisch, as alleged substantially in the form of the complaint attached to the Petition of Bruce J. Landgraf dated January 23, 2012. This includes, but is not limited to, the filing of a criminal complaint and subsequent criminal information and public release of those documents; explanation to the public of the basic nature of the charged case, the procedural context in which charges are being made, and their significance to the criminal justice system; disclosure to persons not already privy to these proceedings as necessary to prepare for and participate in any court hearing, briefing, or trial in the charged case; disclosure to counsel for any defendants all such information that is or reasonably could be discoverable in any charged case.

This Order is not intended to enlarge the scope of discovery that must be made by the State in any charged case.

This Order does not modify the scope or import of the existing Secrecy Order except as reasonably necessary in connection with any charged case(s) involving Kelly Rindfleisch. The Secrecy Order, as amended from time to time during these John Doe proceedings, shall otherwise remain in full force and effect.

This Order may be made public.
