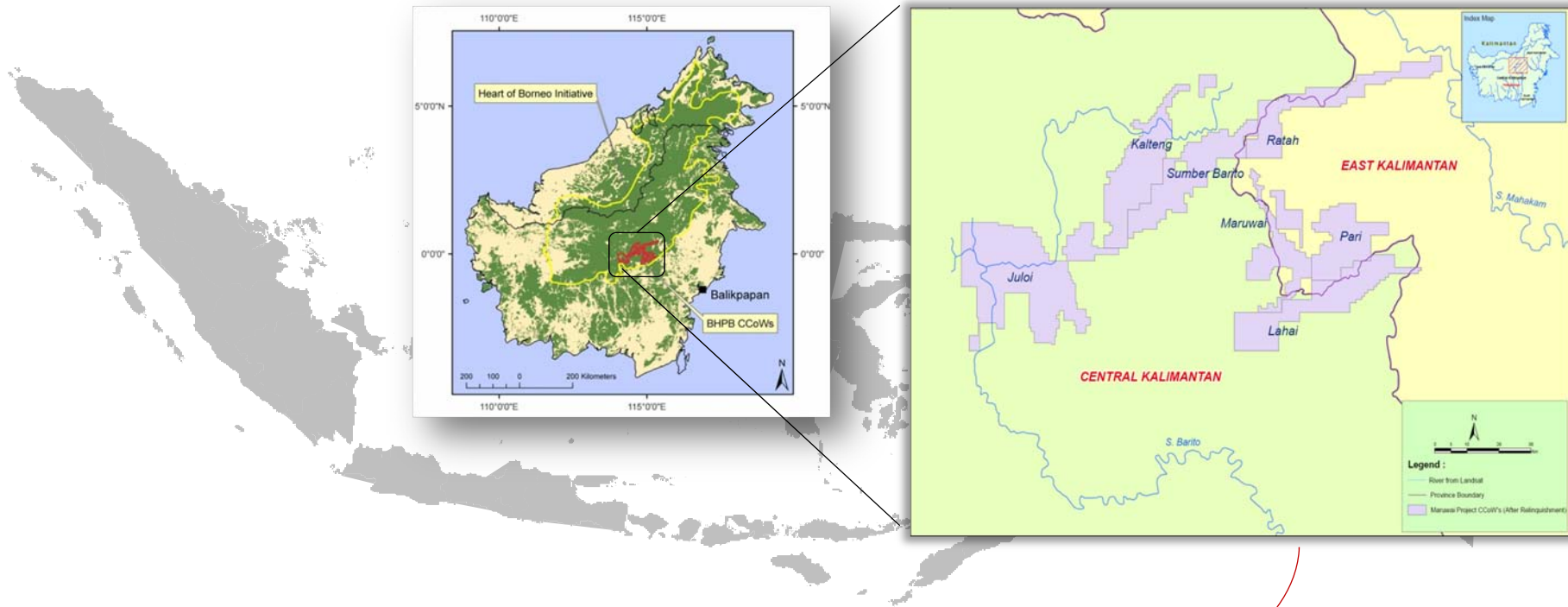

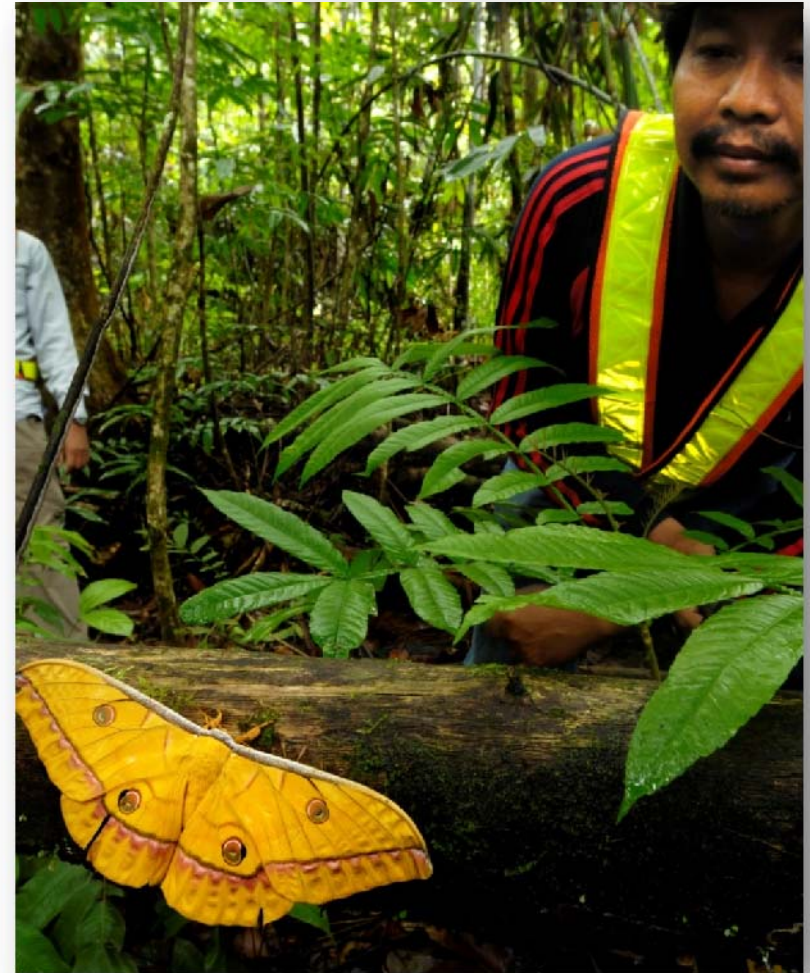

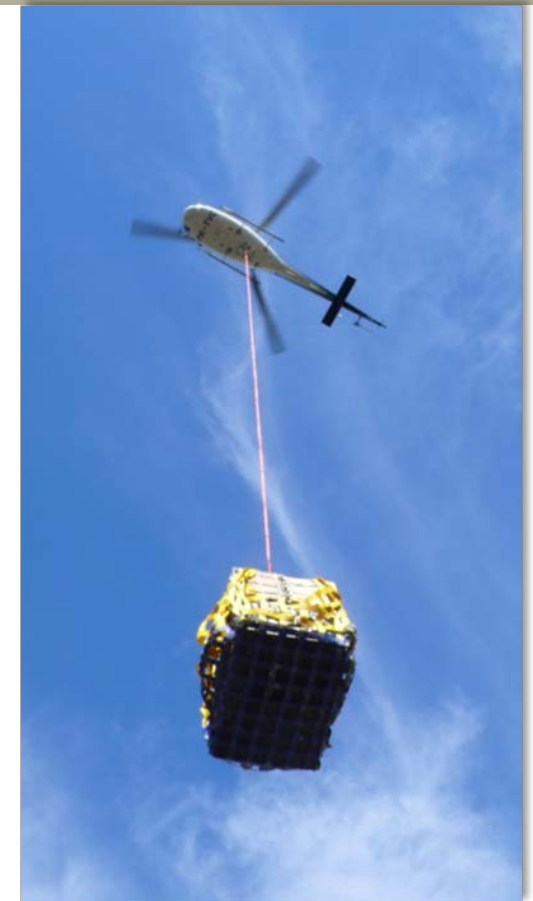
Starting from project inception, we identify, assess and manage specific risks to biodiversity including those posed by closure of an operation

High standards will be implemented around all site locations, for example:

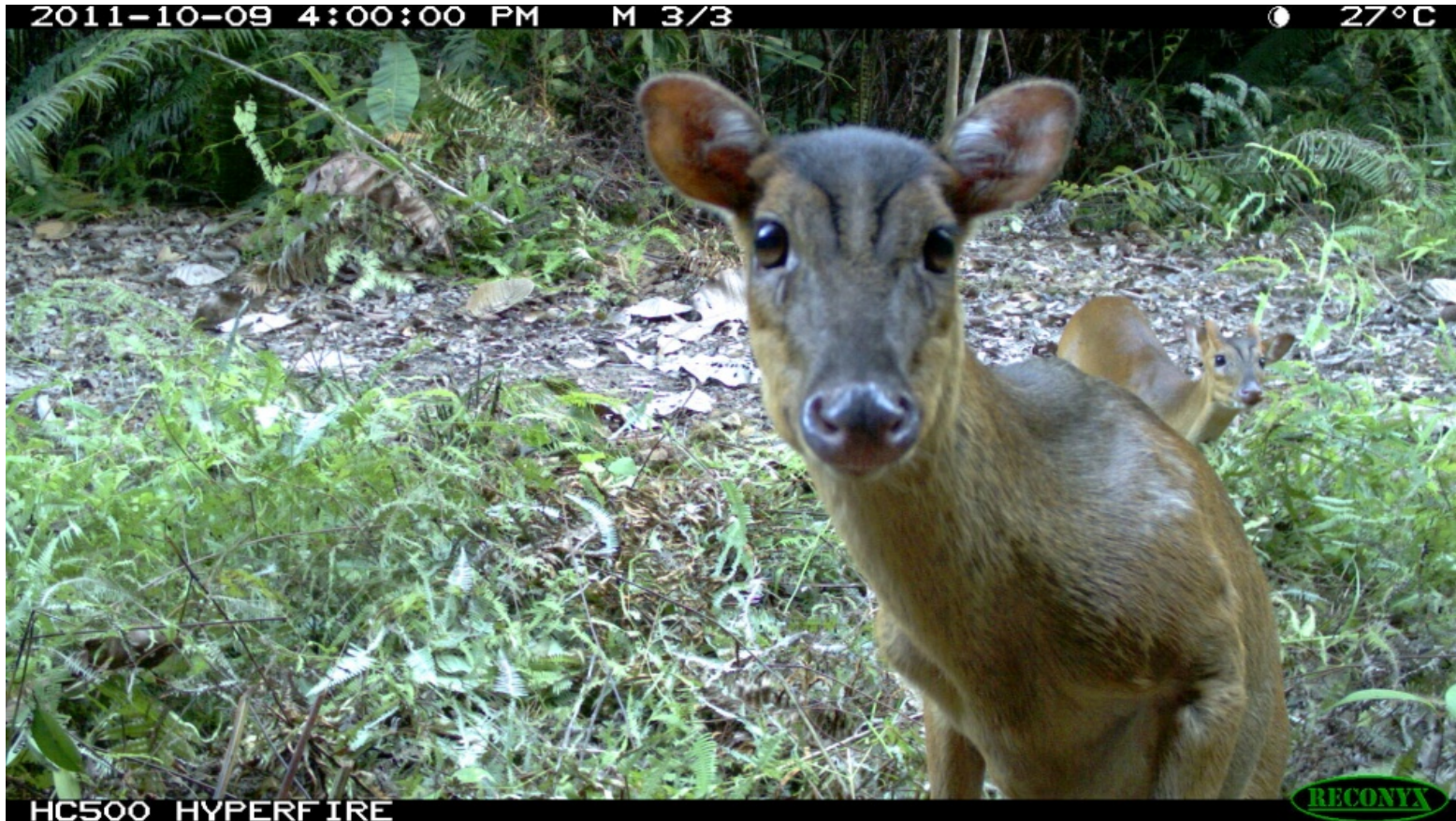
- Clear process for managing land clearing

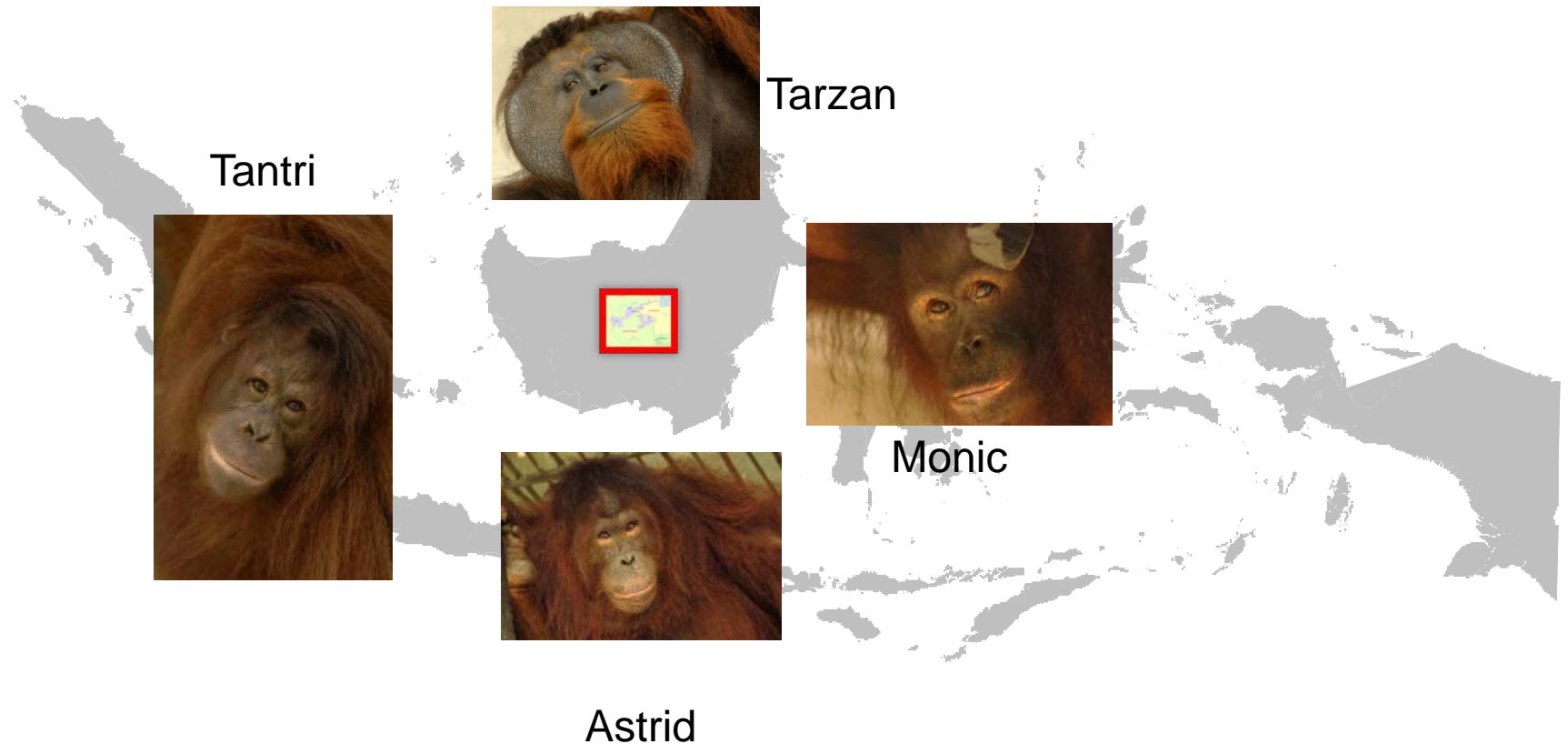
Project with Fauna & Flora International to provide a platform for the enhancement of regional biodiversity and provide long term habitat for orangutan
